Spectator and Off-field Checks

The appropriate check-in process is in place for spectators.

Contact Tracing is in place for spectators and attendance is being recorded to ensure compliance with government guidelines.

- (In the event of a group, one person may take responsibility for that group and provide their details as point of contact in the event contact tracing is necessary.)

Regular checks are being completed to ensure number of spectators remains within the limits. The total number of persons indoors/outdoors (players, coaches, match officials, club/venue staff and spectators) must not exceed the numbers outlined in government guidance.

Areas of high traffic and frequent touch point are being regularly cleaned.

Toilet facilities are being regularly cleaned.

Hygiene station and cleaning supplies are at a sufficient level for the next day of use.
