

2019 CRICKET LEINSTER CLUB GRANT SCHEME – FUNDING PROVIDED BY CRICKET IRELAND

- 1 Grants will be given for between €250 and €1000 on the basis that the club must put up at least 50% of the cost of the project/equipment
- 2 Applications are to be sent to philip.smith@cricketleinster.ie and will be reviewed by the relevant committees.
- 3 Upon any allocation of a grant, approval will be confirmed by the Board and following this the Honorary Treasurer will make the appropriate payment directly to the Honorary Secretary of the club in question on presentation of an invoice for the **completed** work.
- 4 Funding levels are limited. Cricket Leinster reserves the right to prioritize some applications over others based on the needs of the club, and the benefit that the project brings to the playing of cricket in Leinster.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1 The grants are available to clubs competing in competitions run by Cricket Leinster.
- 2 Subscriptions to the Union must be fully up to date.
- 3 Funds must be destined towards a specific identified capital project or piece of equipment. Copies of quotations should accompany the application. It is intended that the capital project or piece of equipment will have direct benefit to the playing of cricket. For example: line marking machines, boundary ropes, scarifiers, upgrades of existing machinery, pitch covers (in particular flat sheets), gazebos to provide shelter, containers for use as storage or as changing rooms.
- 4 Applications must be on the relevant form and signed by two officers of the club.
- 5 The general criteria to obtain the loans are
 - (i) that the capital project or equipment be directly cricket –oriented
 - (ii) that the cricket section of a multi-sports club have the facility to receive and use the funds (this will probably mean having its own bank account etc)
 - (iii) that the project is for the benefit of all cricket members
- 6 The club should be accredited under the Leinster Cricket Union accreditation scheme or should be in the process of becoming accredited or apply to be accredited before the grant is issued.

Applications must be submitted by Friday 6th December 2019.
